# **Importance of Sharing the Gospel**

### **Children's Condition**

# What is the Message of Salvation?

God—Who He is and What He is like

#### Man—Sinful condition

- We are accountable to God—unable to save ourselves (Rom. 3:19b; Titus 3:5)

#### The Gospel—Who Jesus is and What He did

- He is \_\_\_\_\_ man (Rom. 8:3)
- He died on the cross, \_\_\_\_\_ giving His \_\_\_\_\_ to pay for sin (Rom. 5:8, 9)

- He reconciled us—we are no longer enemies, but friends of God (Rom. 5:10, 11)

## **The Appropriation**

- God receives all who believe on Him (Rom. 10:11, 12; Rev. 22:17)
- Man's responsibility (Rom. 10:9, 10, 13)

  - Recognize our sinfulness and repent of that sin
  - Trust on the Lord Jesus, God's provision, in order to be saved
