

# The Romans Road for Children

(Session 5—Truths About the Appropriation)

How do we invite children to respond to the Gospel message?

## Truths to Share with the Children

**THE APPROPRIATION**—God receives all who believe on Him

**Romans 10:13** (Show flashcard)

- \_\_\_\_\_ the verse from the Bible
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ the meaning of the words
  - “Whosoever”
  
  - “Calls on the name of the Lord”
  
  - “Saved”
  
- Give the child an \_\_\_\_\_ to call on God by believing in Jesus
  - Be specific about the decision the children are making.
  - Example: “Perhaps today you have called on Jesus to save you. Or maybe you have some questions about calling on Jesus to save you.”
  
- Have children close their eyes and bow their heads

- Ask them to “\_\_\_\_\_” they would like to talk to you about the decision they made or to ask questions

“If today you have called on the Lord Jesus to be your Savior or if you have questions about calling on Jesus, will you please show me by... (Choose one)

Looking up at me

Raising your hand

Putting up your first finger

- Tell the children where to \_\_\_\_\_ you for counseling

“If you looked at me just now to show you called on Jesus to save you, as soon as class is over I would like you to meet me by (give a specific place). I will show you from the Bible what it means to be saved.”
