**1. Introduction (10) (10)**

Driving car – police stop – No ticket today, just be careful

What if, he gave me \$100? Would this be fair?

Was enthusiastic Yes

Was related to the experience of the child Yes – grace not deserved

**2. Presentation (15) (13)** Reading the vs from the Bible will show the child it is God's Word and not made up.

Established the memory verse as the Word of God Yes OT / NT

OT before Jesus—promised Savior; NT Jesus, born, died

-2 Read the verse directly from the Bible Read from visual only

Taught the Scripture reference (address) Eph, chapt 1, vs 7

**3. Explanation (25) (25)**

Concepts explained "Him"—Jesus "Redemption"—rescued/saved

me, paid price, Jesus only one paid for your sin, "trespasses"—

so not be separated from God, sin—we deserve to be separated;

showed grace—can be forgiven!

Was on the child's level Yes Was clear Yes

Concepts needing explanation \_\_\_\_\_

The intro related to the meaning of the verse!  
Well done!

Clear explanation!

When applying the verse to the saved, the child needs to understand how this verse can be applied to his life, not just be told general Christian growth principles.

**4. Application (20) (16)**

Applied verse clearly to the child's life

-4 not a real application Saved You can grow; Go to church; Read Bible; Pray—  
told what to read from Bible; Obey Bible; Tell others

Unsaved Can do today – can't be good enough, only Jesus

Died, can be forgiven no longer separated

Personal "you" Yes

Repeating the reference before and after helps the child remember where it's found in the Bible.

**5. Repetition (15) (11)**

-1 Used repetition with Scripture reference before and after not before

Method used Freeze on a word

-3 Repeated verse adequately √√ 2x with game

Made learning fun children would enjoy this method

**Overall Presentation (15) (15)**
